CLAHS Reopens Its Museum

Conneaut Lake Area Historical Society will open its museum for the season on Saturday, April 18, at 2 p.m. The museum, located at 150 N. Third St., Conneaut Lake, features many exhibits, including artifacts about Conneaut Lake Park, hotels, military, the Erie Extension Canal, school and sports display as well as others.

Another highlight is the Liberty the Second boat, rescued from the depths of Conneaut Lake in the 1980s after it had sunk in 1920.

A gift shop also allows visitors to purchase items of local interest. In addition, a research center provides information on many subjects.
