Improvements planned

Our museum building and is in need of some major repairs and updates. The roof is leaking, so that is our highest priority. We hope to award a contract to being roof repairs soon.

However, the board believes it is imperative that we have a professional contractor do the cement work and construction stuff to ensure the warranties are good.
